CRACK SEALING CITY STREETS

City street crews have begun crack sealing streets to prevent water from seeping into the cracks, causing deterioration and eroding the base under the streets.



Before crews can seal the cracks, they must first clean the cracks out with high pressure air; a process that scatters rocks and dirt in the street. After the sealant has been placed and has had sufficient time to cure, a street sweeper will clean the debris from the street. This typically occurs the following day.

PI WATER TURNS ON IN APRIL

The pressurized irrigation water will be turned on by April 15 or sooner, depending on the weather. An exact date when the water will be available cannot be given because it takes several weeks to pressurize the system. However, water will be available sooner in the lower elevations of town and to all residents no later than April 15.

Before the water system is turned on, do the following now to avoid unnecessary flooding this spring:

- Turn your irrigation system off at the valve
- Turn your system clock off

Follow these steps to turn your PI valve off:

- Locate valve box, typically in your front yard
- Carefully open the lid checking for spiders that may have nested in your box
- Turn the handle perpendicular to the pipe (so it crosses the pipe)
- With the handle in this position, the PI is turned off
- To turn the water on, turn the valve 90 degrees so the handle is in line with the pipe.



This time of year, you can also check your PI filters to make sure they are clean. Even a partially plugged filter will cause a reduced flow (pressure) and reduced sprinkler performance. Always securely replace the lid to the green box after you open it.

If you have a leak at your PI meter, (water running out of the meter box) take the lid off and reach in and turn the valve OFF. If the leak stops, then the leak is somewhere on your line and you are responsible to fix it. If the leak is coming out of the meter itself, do not attempt to fix it, call Public Works at 801-804-4550.
