

SUMMER UTILITY BILL REMINDER

Summer is here and that means increased air conditioning and pressurized irrigation use. This increased usage leads to larger utility bills. You may notice that there is a lag between your utility usage and when you pay for them. This lag means that your usage at the beginning of the summer won't be paid for until the end of the summer.



For example, the water you use

for your lawn on August 6 won't be paid for until October 20. Because of this timing the largest bills are generally those that are due on the 20 of August, September, and October. We hope this information will help you budget for the larger bills that come at the end of summer.

- Prescription Medication

Do you know which items should not be placed in the recycle cans?

Please **DO NOT** place the following items in a recycle can, they are not recyclable.

Aerosol Cans

Aluminum Foil

- Anything with Food WasteMirrors
- Batteries
- Ceramic

Styrofoam

- Clothing

- Glass
