UTILITY BILL DUE DATE CHANGE

Beginning in January, utility payment due dates will be moved from the 20th of each month to the 25th of each month. With the change, your bill and newsletter will arrive approximately one week later than normal. The bill due on January 25th should be delivered around January 8th and will be for services provided from November 21st through December 20th.

Customers will have until the 25th of each month to pay their bill online, in person, or over the phone. Customers paying through ACH autopay will have their accounts charged on the 25th of each month.

ANIMAL REGISTRATION

Did you know you can (and should) register your pet? Pet registration can be completed in person at the Spanish Fork Police Department (789 W. Center Street), at a participating veterinarian clinic, or at the South Utah Valley Animal Shelter (582 W. 3000 N., Spanish Fork). For dogs, proof of the rabies vaccination will be required. For pets that have been spayed or neutered, the fee is \$15. Otherwise, the fee is \$35.

SPANISH FORK CHORALE


