UTILITY BILL DUE DATE CHANGE

You probably noticed your bill arrived later than it has in the past—bills will now be available near the 8th of each month. This is because the utility bill due date has changed. Bills are now due on the 25th of the month. Those on ACH Autopay will have their accounts charged on the 25th.

The change was made to decrease the time between usage and billing, standardize read times for all utility services, and simplify first and last bills. If you have questions about the change, call or text the utility office at 801-804-4500.

GARBAGE AND RECYCLE PICKUP

Please make sure all garbage cans are out before 7 a.m. on your assigned collection day no matter when your garbage cans are "typically" picked up. Routes are constantly changing as the City grows and with the snow.

It is important that vehicles or trailers are not blocking cans. Cans must not be filled with dirt. sod. asphalt. burned out charcoal/ashes, or large appliances that make the can too heavy for the garbage truck arm to lift. Make sure lids remain closed so rain and snow cannot get into cans, weighing down the garbage and contaminating the recyclable materials.

CEMETERY DECORATIONS & CLEANUP

The decorations policy allows shepherd hooks only from Nov 1 through Mar 1 and the week of Memorial Day.

Shepherd hooks must be removed by patrons before March 1st. Remaining shepherd hooks will be collected and discarded by cemetery

staff after March 1.

This includes the shepherd hooks and vertical structures that were left behind in the storage compound last October. The Cemetery will not store shepherd hooks in the off season.

Winter Cleanup: Cemetery staff discards winter decorations on Feb 21.













GREEN WASTE FOR SPRING CLEANUP

Residents can download three (3) free vouchers a year that allow them to take loads of green waste to the transfer station. The transfer station is located at 2450 W 400 S. Springville.

These vouchers give a \$10 credit for each load. This is the typical charge for a pickup truck sized load of covered green waste (440 lbs.).

You will need to download, print, and bring the paper copy of the voucher to the transfer station when you drop off your green waste. They will not accept the vouchers electronically.

Vouchers are scanned to ensure that no more than three are used for each residence. Download vouchers at the spanishfork.org/greenwaste.




SAFETY TIP FOR WINTER DRIVING
